
very much appreciate your vigilance in testing if either yourselves or your child/ren present with symptoms. If your child does develop any symptoms while with us you will be contacted to collect them and either take them for a PCR test then send the result to us or isolate them from the setting for 10 days. This will ensure we have the appropriate measures are in place.

Please **DO NOT** give your child Calpol or equivalent before attending the setting. It is becoming apparent that a few children have been given this before arrival and once worn off symptoms return. If they need a pain killer we will administer it on their arrival (for teething or other agreed conditions) - Please do also continue to wear masks and encourage the use of the hand sanitizer's at the settings doors.

A gentle reminder of the need to keep to your agreed times when attending the setting. The girls will ask you to wait in a designated area or to come back at the specified time if arriving early. If you arrive before 8am we will not permit you to enter the buildings as our insurance runs between the hours of 8.00am and 6.00pm.




Equally it is important to arrive on time for both your child who may enter in on an already established session so causing them to feel unsettled and for the staff who may be waiting to include your child into an activity.
